

HELPFUL HINTS FOR EXPO

Be sure to review the class supply list(s) and bring all the necessary supplies.

There will be no wheeled carts allowed in Vendor Mall, with the exception of going to and from a Make-It/Take-It class. We will have an area available to check your sewing machine after your class is completed, or you can return it to your vehicle.

You will be taking notes in your lap, so bring a notebook with a hardcover or a clipboard.

Please put cell phones on vibrate or turn it off before any class or lecture/demo begins. Ringing interrupts the class and is very annoying to fellow attendees.

Always ask permission before taking pictures of garments or projects and before recording any class lecture/demo.

Handle samples and garments carefully. Cap your pen and put it down while viewing samples.

It may be cooler than you would like in the Conference Center, so bring a sweater or jacket. Dressing in layers is the best option anytime you are attending an event in a large space. It is impossible for the air conditioning to be even throughout the center.

Wear comfortable shoes.

Bring cash, your checkbook and credit cards – all three.

Bring address labels – it makes it much easier to sign up for mailing lists and door prize drawings.

Names will be drawn for door prizes daily at noon and 4:00 PM. The names will be posted on a board at the ASG table. You must be present to win.

Be aware of any special dietary needs and plan accordingly. There will be food available for purchase both days. The buffet on Friday evening will begin at 6:30 PM. If you need something between lunch and that time, bring some crackers.
