Judy Kessinger—a favorite at the 2011 Indy Sewing Expo, will be the guest speaker at our annual meeting this year.

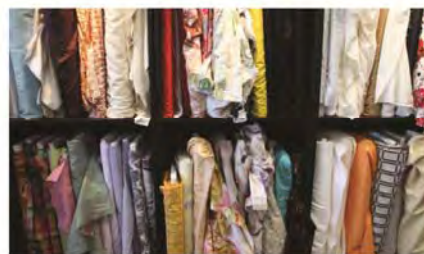
Judy will offer workshops on Thursday November 1, and Friday November 2, prior to the meeting on Saturday.

This applies to those who did not receive a card in the mail, lost cards, and new members. New members will receive these directions in their new-member packet also.

The new Jo-Ann VIP Discount Cards was mailed to all ASG members in August. They arrived as a large postcard which included the discount card. The new card is valid from 8/1/11-8/31/12. The VIP Card can be used for 10% off your total purchase, including regular and sale priced items. For in-store purchases, the Jo-Ann 40% off regular priced item coupons can be used in the same transaction as the VIP Card 10% total purchase discount, although the 10% would not apply to the item that receives the 40% discount. For online orders, the VIP discount cannot be combined with any other offer.
